### **Answer:**

To Support TPM2.0 under Windows 7, there are some requirements as listed below.

- a. The OS version must be "Windows 7 Enterprise" or "Windows 7 Ultimate".
- b. A 64-bit operating system environment is required.
- c. The OS needs to be installed under UEFI mode.
- d. Install Microsoft Hotfix from the following link.

- e. Make sure your BIOS version is supported.
